- 3. Isaiah is mentioned by name 22 times and quoted dozens of times in the New Testament. What is your favorite New Testament quote of the book of Isaiah?

4. Isaiah prophecies during the reigns of which kings (Isaiah 1:1)? What happens in the year Uzziah dies (Isaiah 6:1)?

5. What are the four names in Isaiah 7-9 (7:3, 14; 8:1; 9:6)? What point Isaiah is making? What does God want Ahaz to do?

6. Who are Isaiah 13-23 addressed to? Why?

7. How is Isaiah 36–39 different from the rest of the book? What similarities are there between Isaiah 7–12 and Isaiah 36–39? What can we learn from these two sections of the book?

8. People often argue that Isaiah 40-66 were not written by Isaiah. What does the New Testament say about this (John 12:38-41; Isaiah 53:1; 6:10)? What is the message of Isaiah 40-66?

9. How can studying the historical context of the book of Isaiah help us understand the book better?
